



Rob McHaffie was born in Melbourne, Australia in 1978, and lives and works in Castlemaine, Victoria.

McHaffie's painting, drawing and ceramic portraiture of characters, both real and imagined, offer an engagement with themes of personal healing, family life, human relationships and the foibles of contemporary times. In his early works, these characters were clumsily modelled in clay, wigs or scrunched tissues. Their bodies intimated by empty piles of rumpled clothing. He added scraps of fabric, found objects and other bric-a-brac to create imagined scenery.

A major survey exhibition at the Bendigo Art Gallery opened in August 2024. 'Rob McHaffie: We Are Family' continues until late January 2025


Rob McHaffie has been the recipient of several awards and residencies. In 2016 he won the Local Art Prize, Bayside Acquisitive Art Prize, Bayside Arts and Cultural Centre, Melbourne, in 2014 he won the Geelong contemporary art prize and in 2012 he was awarded the Art & Australia / Credit Suisse Private Banking Contemporary Art Award.

In 2011 McHaffie undertook an Asialink residency at Rimbun Dahan, Malaysia and in 2007 he was a recipient of the Cité Internationale des Arts Residency, Paris, France.



























